### Of Edward Kay's spiritual heritage

#### The Meaning of Life

Charlene Hamilton is a sometimes rude, but essentially warm-hearted person. She just brought me a cup of tea and some biscuits and offered me a cigarette. Is that not the very soul of transcendence?

In order not to misunderstand Ken Winehouse, we have to assume that God does not exist outside the Universe. He is the Universe. And we have to adjust to the idea that we do not live *in* the universe but are a part of it.

Now we come to something truly astonishing: Winehouse is of the opinion that every single one of us creates and lives the meaning of life. Because we already transcend, seeing the world through God's eyes, because we already try to comprehend the world, we fulfil – even if unconsciously and with varying degrees of success – the meaning of life.

The meaning of live is evolution.

Evolution is the motion through which the world reflects and develops itself, not just biologically, bur also intellectually, technically and culturally.

Since God does not exist outside the world but in and of the World, evolution [the way from one to many] is not only the strongest of human drives, but also God's will, i.e., our highest duty, the meaning of life, namely that which we are familiar with under the term *progress* (technology, science, art, etc.). Whether we are conscious of it or not, we are part of an ever-manifesting creation.


So this is the meaning of life. No wonder that nobody has found it, if it is true and nobody has been able to agree on the meaning of life. Why travel far afield when the answer is right here at hand? And although it is right there in front of us, we overlook it, but according to Winehouse, we nonetheless find it over and over again. Now it is clear why he said that life as we know it is not absurd, not a fallacy, not a punishment, not a test, but service to the world, the world serves itself.

In that the faith-based religions propagate bliss and redemption [in heaven] through faith [to make it as easy as possible for people in order to lure them into their fold] and not through creative service in and to the world, they are guilty of betraying God's will.

As in the choir of angels at the end of Goethe's *Faust*:

Whoever strives to the utmost/for him there is salvation.

## Order

The clear, concise arrangement of the true, scientific formation of concepts in a systematic fashion. In politics, the establishment of living conditions to fit the character of the population based on their rights. Metaphysically as a useful unit of multiplicity (Integrality. Cosmos = Order). Intellectual, philosophical and spiritual order through awareness of self, the world and oneself in the world and to find, improve, realise, verify, care for nature as it is realised in the organism to organise, hold together, inspire and find the growing cosmos (universe, god, spirit, material). The activities that are productive to humankind converge to create order =

Development (Involution = the movement from many (back) to one

Progress + Development = Integrality

Materiality + Spirituality =

Integrality

The concrete + The abstract  
= Integrality

Reason + Feeling =  
Integrality

Male principle + Female  
principle = Integrality




The pain is fresh, we still can learn why the New York City Council funds courses in which beggars are retrained as figureheads of a new era.
